



Mayor Nicholas J. Sacco, Commissioner Hugo D. Cabrera, Commissioner Allen Pascual and Chief Robert J. Dowd are happy to announce the continuation of the North Bergen Junior Police Academy for the 2016 summer season. In conjunction with this year's summer fun program, the North Bergen Junior Police Academy is for North Bergen Township children entering the 7th grade or 8th Grade as of September 2016. The Junior Police Academy will be held at a location within the Township of North Bergen.

The Junior Police Academy is not a "boot camp" for troubled youth, but a camp designed to operate like an actual police academy for those interested in law enforcement and for students that show they have leadership skills.

The objective of the Junior Police Academy is to educate the cadets with various police procedures, history of the North Bergen Township Police Department, tours of the Police Headquarters, field trip to the NJ State Police Museum and Learning Center and/or field trip to the 911 Memorial & Museum and give them comprehensive understanding of what it takes to succeed in the profession of law enforcement.

Cadets should be prepared for an experience spanning a wide variety of Law Enforcement techniques and training. We place strong emphasis on self-respect, respect of others, teamwork and commitment to one's goals. This will be accomplished through structured events which will be offered in a fun, informative, interactive, educational and hands-on manner. The curriculum will consist of educational activities as well as physical training activities.

The Junior Police Academy will run for five consecutive days, starting on Monday and ending on Friday. The academy will run for one week. The class will not exceed 30 cadets. The academy class will be held from July 18, 2016 to July 22, 2016. Cadets will be placed in an academy class based on first come first served, with all the necessary paperwork filled out properly. The Junior Police Academy will be held at the Lincoln School Annex located at 1206 63rd Street (Smith Ave. Entrance).

Requirements: Perspective Cadets must meet and complete below listed requirements.
PLEASE PRINT ALL INFORMATION NEATLY.

1. Complete the cadet application. Applications must be completed in black or blue ink and signed.
2. One letter of recommendation from a teacher, principal or vice principal.
3. Completed essay question: **“Why do you want to participate in the North Bergen Junior Police Academy? What do you hope to accomplish from it?”**
4. Must be an incoming 7th or 8th grade student as of September 2016
5. Must be a Township of North Bergen resident.

Please be reminded, that the North Bergen Police Department, the North Bergen Recreation Department and the Township of North Bergen hold the right to exclude admission into the North Bergen Police Junior Police Academy due to application error, failure to meet application requirements and any acts of juvenile delinquency committed by a perspective Junior Police Academy cadet.

If you are accepted to attend the Junior Police Academy, you will receive an acceptance letter along with a medical certification form, medical release form, a civil liability form, range clearance form and a media release form in the mail no later than June 15, 2016. At that time you must mail a non-refundable check or money order in the amount of \$25.00 made payable to the North Bergen Recreation Department with Junior Police Academy writing in the memo space. You should also mail back your completed medical certification form, medical release form, range clearance form, a civil liability form and a media release form by June 25, 2016 to the following address:
