- ✓ Introduction to Firearm Safety

- √ First Aid and CPR
- ✓ Police Defensive Tactics
- √ Vehicular Pursuit
- ✓ Police Response to Mentally III and Special Needs
- ✓ Specialized Units and Their Functions

WHY PARTICIPATE?

Participants with more that 2 absences will not receive a certificate of completion.

This Academy does not make you a police officer. The participation and completion of this series of classes is designed to foster partnerships with the community. Completion of this course does not grant police powers or authority to any participant.
